### **Cumbria Highways**

The Parish Council is indebted to Cumbria Highways department for all their hard work in maintaining the road network within the Parish, during the year.

Obtaining funding for laying a new Langwathby Bridge surface, along with the resurfacing of the road through Langwathby village, was a major project that was actioned very efficiently and completed on time. The work has been much appreciated.

The extension of double white lines on the A686, pushed for by the Parish Council, will contribute greatly to road safety.

### Westmorland and Furness Council

The transition to this new single authority appears to have gone smoothly from a Parish Council administration point of view. Time will tell how the new authority beds in.

### Langwathby Village Hall Renovation Project

This project is moving forward slowly. Plans have been drawn up and Planning Permission has been granted.

Applications for grant funding is ongoing.

The total cost of the project will be in excess of £1m. Once completed, this renovated, environmentally efficient, venue should serve the local community well, for many future decades.

### May 2023 Parish Elections

Neither the Langwathby nor Edenhall Wards were contested, with all Councillors being re-elected, bar Cllr Ian Harrington, who chose not to stand.
